

2009 Constructed Championship Fact Sheet

Event Dates

The tournament will run from August 14th—August 16th, 2009 at GenCon, Indianapolis.

Format

- 200-point Constructed Assault format, according to the most current edition of the Dungeons and Dragons® Miniatures Game Battle Rules.
- Warband Construction for the GenCon Constructed Championship will use special warband building rules.
 Players should assign a map to their warband from the limited choices below. Consult the floor rules; only legal (unbanned) minatures may be used. Finally, warbands may not include more than 3 of any miniature.
 Players must bring pen, paper, battle map, miniatures, cards, and counters as needed.
- The following map rotation will be used for Championship Stages I and II:

Rounds 1 & 4: Temple of the Unseeing

Rounds 2 & 5: Fallen Fortress Rounds 3 & 6: Warband Map

Further maps for Stage II, as necessary, and those for stage III

will be anounced during the tournament.

Players must assign one of the following 6 maps to their warband: Broken Demongate, Dragon Shrine, Magma Keep, Fane of Lolth, The King's Road or Dwarven Outpost.

- Swiss rounds through stages I and II Maximum length of 60 minutes per round.
- Qualifier winners and runners up, as well as the top 40 ranked constructed players (Standard and Vintage) and the 2008 limited champion and 2008 constructed champions will receive byes through stage I.
- The top 8 players after the Swiss rounds will enter a Stage III single-elimination playoff bracket.
